

GLOSSARY OF TERMS

We can all draw close to Him with the veil removed from our faces.
And with no veil we all become like mirrors who brightly reflect the
glory of the Lord Jesus.

- 2 Cor 3:18a



1. Invitation

God created us simply to worship Him and have relationship with Him. However, the enemy came in the Garden and robbed the world of its connection to God.

The WHOLE of creation now eagerly waits for the mature sons and daughters of God to be revealed to be liberated from its bondage. Rom 8:19-22.

So, we as Christians have an obligation for the sake of the whole of creation to stand up and become mature sons and daughters of God to liberate it. The invitation is to grow in maturity. The journey is relationship along the path- the fruit is the visible, tangible sign of maturing.

He wants us to see ourselves through His eyes. He delights in us, yet He never forces Himself on us because of His love. God is all about invitation.

The Law was God giving the people what they chose. He offered them a relationship, but they chose to be separate from God by distancing themselves. Jesus came to restore that relationship back to Pappa.

We are on a rescue mission-are you up for the invitation?

2. Shine Your light.

"When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness but will have the light of life." John 8:12 NIV

Are you aware that as you stroll through the day in your usual surroundings you are like a torch passing through a cave – bringing light, warmth, and hope everywhere you go? Begin to see yourself as a 'torch carrier', setting things alight!

Signs that the light of His presence is shining through you and is bearing fruit, is that your perspectives of the world around you are changing. You see options and opportunities.

We also often pray to Papa to "shine His light" in the darkness so that truth can be revealed as He sees it. This we often do on land assignments. it's amazing what happens when we do this!

The world is a dark place full of deceit and "lies upon lies". The world is largely a place missing the revelation of God's love which brings light. Speaking forth Gods light into a place or situation helps us to begin to see Truth and His point of view, unlike our point of view which is blinded by the conditions we see before us.

3. DAILY BREAD

"Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread." Matt 6:10-11 NIV

The Lord's Prayer says that "Give us this day our daily bread" what was Jesus saying about bread?

Typically, lack of financial resources occupies most people's thoughts a lot, yet for Him, financial matters are (although important to Him) the least of His concerns for us. He will give us what we need when we need it.

When we ask for daily bread, it goes beyond eating and drinking (read finances) but also for portions of revelation, goodness, grace-ALL the spiritual and physical needs for that day.

So, every day we face a world not knowing what lies before us. We then must trust that today's portion is enough provision. Having that certain knowledge will also give us peace to face the day.

"What no eye has seen, what no ear has heard, and what no human mind has conceived"—the things God has prepared for those who love him—"1 Cor 2:9

Once we start believing in bread for today, we can expand our mindset and start to begin to IMAGINE the seemingly impossible for tomorrow!

4. YOUR WILL, YOUR WAY

“Seek first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness” Mat 6:33.

His will? The trouble is we are ruled by what we see IN THE NATURAL- this gives us limited vision. As we trust for daily bread portions our faith grows and so with it, our vision of what He desires for us. We overcome fear. We learn to recognise gardens and fields. He will fulfill that promise bit by bit every day. You will receive what no eye has seen. (every day)

God has a bigger plan to rescue everyone! You are part of that rescue plan!

Every day we give up worry, self-centeredness, deception, manipulation, coercion, and fear (everything that is “Not Love) and exchange it for choosing to do things His way we receive a freedom that only He can give.

**“Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;”
Prov 3:5**

5. THE RESCUE

The purpose of life and our Christian walk is to perform the rescue mission.

All of creation is held prisoner by selfishness primarily through these lies -Deception, Coercion, Manipulations, Control.

Most people are walking with either a sense of SHAME, GUILT or FEAR because of falling victim to the above lies. The enemy wants to keep people from seeing the truth. That Jesus died so that ALL may enter the Kingdom-that there IS a way to be free of the above.

Gods people need to be helping people be set free from the above-in order to reach everyone, we need to dismantle deception so people can see the truth.

*Captives are those that through their life choices put themselves into jail and the Prisoners are those that are there because of the actions of others (iniquity, systems etc.)

6. THE WAIT

The Wait is a special time with Pappa. We come to Him with no agenda, no lists etc. but simply to sit with Him and say, “here I am”. Sometimes words or revelation comes and sometimes not. The idea is not about “performance” but about resting at His feet.

Choose a quiet place and put on calm background worship-sit back and invite Him in.

Keep a pen and paper handy in case you do receive a revelation on something.

7. COVENANTS IN THE KETUBAH (there is a separate booklet with more detail).

We can see throughout the story of the Bible that Pappa was setting up a wedding ceremony between Himself and His people. The Ketubah is a Hebrew marriage contract with various stages of the contract evolving into a marriage ceremony. In studying the Ketubah we learn a few very enlightening things about our journey with Pappa and the Ketubah.

1. FEAR AND SERVANTHOOD.

The first cup of wine is drunk between the parties called the cup of Sanctification. It is the beginning stages of the contract. It is in this that we move from slavery into servanthood. We move from fear and our DNA is rewritten and restored back to Him.

2. OBEDIENCE AND FRIENDSHIP.

The second cup of wine is drunk-the cup of dedication.2 parties mix salt and conclude negotiations. In this stage we learn that Jesus is our friend, and our prayer life takes on a new dimension-one of conversation. We sit and wait with Him.

3. INHERITANCE AND SONSHIP.

The third cup of wine is drunk as negotiations are concluded. The bride can now officially share in the inheritance of the groom as they are legally bound. It is a time that sons take authority as they enter more fully into their new identity.

4. LOVE AND THE BRIDE

The fourth cup is consumed, and it is a cup of praise. This is the stage of intimacy. The groom vows not to drink wine again until he is united with his bride. He goes to prepare a place just for him and his bride. He perhaps realises that his bride is not perfect and he, out of love, takes the sin on himself that his bride should have paid the price for. Also, in this stage there is no longer a sense of obligation.

5. AUTHORITY AND THE WIFE.

In Proverbs 31 we learn about the wife. After establishing ourselves as the bride of Christ we need to explore that place of intimacy where we appropriate the authority and maturity of being a wife. We need to move into authority of our walk with Christ. We will need to learn to rule, reign and judge with Him beside us. We also need to understand that there is a fundamental difference between Hebrew and Greek thinking. Hebrew thinking goes beyond just being saved and waiting to go to heaven.

8. TRANSPARENCY

Transparency is to let light shine through something.

Jesus was transparent in everything that He did. His goal was that we would see the Father right through Him. Everything that He did was easily documented and confirmed, because none of it was done in secret.

He encourages us as well not to hide our light, but to let it shine before all men.

...there is nothing concealed that will not be disclosed or hidden that will not be made known.³ What you have said in the dark will be heard in the daylight, and what you have whispered in the ear in the inner rooms will be proclaimed from the roofs." Luke 12:1-3

He calls us not to live a life of hypocrisy; trying to cover up our sin and our problems, acting as though we do not have any, but to deal with our baggage, quickly and openly. Giving the devil no opportunity to come against us, or to use secret sin as a foothold in our life, a foundation to build more iniquity upon.

1. Humility

is the God given self-assurance that eliminates the need to prove to others the worth of who you are, and the rightness of what you do "Satan fears virtue.

2. Fear

Those who know perfect Love, know no fear.

There is no fear where love exists. Rather, perfect love banishes fear, for fear involves punishment, and the person who lives in fear has not been perfected in love. 1 Jhn :18 NIV.

Do I live a transparent life before men? Or have I built walls around me due to fear of exposure? Are your boundaries healthy ones or are they hindering your ability to get real with the lost and broken?

There is NOTHING hidden from Him. Walk like that, knowing His presence is with you everywhere, even the darkest places you go to.

9. VULNERABILITY

This is the answer to shame-to come out-to reveal! Shame prevents us from being transparent. Light destroys shame. Nothing is hidden from Him-He sees it all anyway.

When we risk bringing things into the light, we become vulnerable!

1. Authentic and real

2. No guarantees

3. To be seen DEEPLY and love FULLY with no guarantees

4. Causes us to invest in relationships that may not work.

5. To repent and not apologise

6. Take risks where the result could be terrible (my father raped me)

7. Causes our relationship with Him to become closer and increases our faith.

8. More of Him and less of us-to KNOW that you KNOW

9. Christ was our example-leaving the safety of heaven to be beaten, betrayed, and killed.

10. Shame

What is shame? What is guilt?

SHAME is the feeling that you are bad as a person. Unlovable, disgraced, embarrassed, dishonoured, undeserving. I.e. you are imperfect and lacking.

GUILT is a bad feeling caused by knowing or thinking that you have done something bad or wrong. You broke the rules!

We are made in His image yet the Liar causes us to question God's character. If we see Him as untrustworthy and imperfect, then the image we have of ourselves will be the same.

Shame is not something God caused is the fingerprint of the enemy -it is an effect of our lack of trust in Him to totally forgive...

11. FORGIVENESS

We forgive first and foremost as an act of obedience because Jesus commanded it and because He has forgiven all of us. Forgiveness is a choice, not a feeling. Secondly, we forgive as an act of trust, trust in our Heavenly Father as the Just Judge. And thirdly, we forgive because it will bring us into a place of freedom. We have all heard the saying that unforgiveness is like drinking poison and expecting the other person to die...

Forgiveness is:

- Forgiveness says you do not owe me anymore.
- Forgiveness is to let go of the person, and what they did, and to release it all to God.
- Forgiveness is returning to God the right to take care of justice.
- Forgiveness can be a process as we might need time to work through our emotions.
- Forgiveness starts with a decision...

12. STEWARDSHIP, PIPELINE, INVESTMENT

STEWARDSHIP

In defining "Stewardship" we: Acknowledge the "ownership" of creation and obedience to His word, as commanded. This requires hearing from Pappa, utilizing and managing all He provides for the glory of God and the betterment of His creation.

All He provides is not only finance but also talents, material items, time and ALL the Lords created.

PIPELINE

Investing in the Kingdom", in obedience to Pappa's leading, you will cause blessing to flow through your pipeline. How do I get flow through my pipeline? There is no one complete answer to this question as all of us are in different places, but the Word provides us with foundational building blocks. A good place to start is Mat 6:33; 10. Investing in the Kingdom is referring to investing from all that God has provided you with.

INVESTMENT

Access does not advocate tithing as taught in most traditional churches. We believe that Paul (2Cor 9:6-15) provides a sound basis for investing in the kingdom. It is between the individual and Pappa what, where, when and the value of what they invest. The one certainty is that you will be judged by the measure you give.

13. LIFESTYLE CHOICES

We speak often about Lifestyle choices, and many of us forget that our choices have far reaching consequences and carries enormous power to change generations. If we want what God has for us, then we must lay down selfishness and take a step back and look at the bigger kingdom picture. We pray, "Your will be done", but often we make our life choices about our will and what is easier for us. When we walk in relationship with the Father, we learn more about submission to Him and His will. Submission to God helps us to be less self-centered and allows us to consider His desires for us and we can claim His grace, wisdom, power, and blessing. "Your will be done on earth", comes from a place of relationship, because we need to be speaking to Pappa about our choices and hearing his will. "His will, His way"

14. INHALE EXHALE REST

The unpronounceable name of God is YHWH. However, as we inhale, the YH is whispered, and as we exhale, WH is expressed. We can give nothing without first receiving it, and as we inhale Him and receive Him into us, we get to exchange what He has for us, with what we have for Him (our “stuff”, our praise, our thankfulness). An intimate exchange.

15. COVENANT VS CONDITION.

Covenant is a contract. In the Bible, an agreement between God and his people, in which God makes promises to his people and, usually, requires certain conduct from them.

There are two types of covenants: conditional and unconditional. A conditional or bilateral covenant is an agreement that is binding on both parties for its fulfilment. Both parties agree to fulfil certain conditions. If either party fails to meet their responsibilities, the covenant is broken and neither party has to fulfil the expectations of the covenant. An unconditional or unilateral covenant is an agreement between two parties, but only one of the two parties has to do something. Nothing is required of the other party.

16. COVENANT NAMES.

The names of God describe Him but are also the covenants He has made with His people.

Our names are precious to us.... they reveal who we are. They are a personal connection, a unique part of us. Names in Biblical times were very important, as they revealed a person's character. God has many Names and each reveals Him in a different way. God's Names represent His attributes, His nature.

Therefore, it is important that we know God by His many Names. By calling upon Him using His various Names...to do so will be an awesome experience in knowing God.

Abraham named God “Jehovah Jireh” – the Lord our Provider. Gen 22.

That is just one example.

Names are revelatory and identify. As we experience Pappa's love, provision, deliverance, healing, safety etc. we will start to have our favourite term of endearment for Him. As we understand how He sees us and our own potential in Jesus, He invites you to that place where you find your name of how He sees you. Friends and family with Access will assist you in hearing a name for you-you can decide how it fits you.

It is your choice if you then function in that name. This is not the name you get written on the white stone but a name of endearment as a Bride and Groom would have for each other.

17. CESSORS OVERVIEW

Cessors started as a prayer ministry within Access in Feb 2024. It is in its fledgling stage at present however we envisage Cessors to encapsulate the following prayer strategies:

- We won't all be sitting in a circle praying about everything under the sun, or praying what we think the solution is. We want to hear the strategy of heaven and pray it into being. It is a break from the traditional church style of intercession we first hear with clear hearts what Pappa wants us to pray.
- Each person or group will take ownership of a FIELD which Pappa will put on their heart. Examples of a field could be the weather, or marriages, or pollution or old age or DNA or transport or whatever. Prayer strategy is not focused on condition but rather on seeking the true covenant in a particular field.
- A once-a-month get-together to report back and celebrate outcomes are planned for now.

18. ICU

The name ICU has double meaning. First, it is an intensive care unit. A place where you are intensely cared for. In a ministry setting our team asks Father God how He sees you.... And the ICU becomes the “I see you” room. When His word gets released to you, you get a revelation, or maybe a reminder, of how He sees you. When we realise, or remember how God sees us, we get to see everything else more clearly.

“And she called the Lord who spoke to her, ‘You are El-roi’ which means ‘Have I not gone on seeing after He saw me!’ Genesis 16:13.

Within an ICU session, each one is reminded that they are seen and how they are seen by the God of all.

19. THREADED APP.

This is an application designed to be used for Terraforming / Land Missions. It connects teams locally and globally. It collects, distributes and saves relevant information to each assignment. It also gives access to relevant informational resources. Access to this system is granted once you begin to participate in Land Assignments.

20. T4-TERRAFORMING

Terraforming (T4) means the transformation of creation for the kingdom of God.

Can be used for business, work environment, relationships etc.

It is done by people of God liberating creation from decay.

Humanity is the sum of our choices and creation either thrives in those choices or suffers under them. Lifestyle dependent.

¹⁹ For the creation waits in eager expectation for the children of God to be revealed. ²⁰ For the creation was subjected to frustration, not by its own choice, but by the will of the one who subjected it, in hope ²¹ that[a] the creation itself will be liberated from its bondage to decay and brought into the freedom and glory of the children of God. Rom 8:19-21 NIV

Scripture calls us to change the atmosphere of earth from one that is hostile to the Kingdom of God to one that is hospitable to the Kingdom of God. We do this by repentance and forgiveness while praying for the geographical area, business, or situation.

21. FISHING NETS

Fishing Nets is based on the principle that if an organisation casts its nets in the places that the Lord shows them, they will catch more donors. The purpose of Fishing Nets is to enable organisations to become self-sustainable. The assistance given to help obtain sustainability may include, but it not limited to:

- obtaining NPO and section 18A tax exemption
- funding organisations so that they can employ a fund raiser for a specified period.
- training/ mentoring fund raisers and assisting with the implementation of strategies and monitoring processes.

22. FAMILY LIFE

We know that families and communities have always been central to God's plan. They are the fundamental building blocks of strong Godly societies.

Families are where we can feel love and learn how to love others. Life is tough, and we need a greater family that we can lean on.

Family Life is a safe haven where we can get advice, support, and get to know more about the Love of the Father in everyday situations. We get together one Wednesday evening per month, where we unpack and discuss everyday life issues in an open forum free from judgement. Family Life is an opportunity for us to explore Godly principles and direction for everyday life. “What does it look like on Monday morning?”

23. TRADING POST

Access 41 is always looking for opportunities to help kick start a business or a self-funding charitable organization. At Trading Post, we look at well-motivated business plans that will be thoroughly reviewed and researched. Should the request for funding pass the initial review the proposal will be forwarded to the directors of Access 41 Property for a final decision.

24. FILLING STATION

The Filling Station assists the pressing needs of families, individuals and communities, to become self-sustainable by walking a road with them and sharing Pappa's resources in whichever form is required. Fundamentally, seeking Pappa's will and His strategies for a way forward, in a challenging time in their lives. Helping them reach their full potential, in their design, Pappa's way. We encourage a holistic approach, in seeking Pappa in prayer, booking a prayer app, meeting regularly, attending Gatherings.

25. HONOUR

As Christians, we need to be the world's greatest example of high integrity and honour and we need to be the ones showing the way. We need to go back to the Source of honour (God) and learn how to live an honourable life, honouring God, our spouse, the elderly, our church leaders, those in government, your children, your boss and pretty much everyone else.

By honouring those that are not honourable, we honour God, we learn to see people the way He does. God calls us to honour Him with our finances, the way we treat others, honour Him by walking in Faith, honesty, truth, and integrity. The only way we can do that is to enter into a personal intimate relationship with Him which enables us to shine His light in the world.

If you want to receive honour, you must give honour. If you want to experience honour, you must embrace humility.

26. WORSHIP

God is enthroned upon the praises of His people. God inhabits the praise of His people. It is in this place that our Wednesday worship evenings are the building block for the Access41 ministry. It is a place of intimacy with the Father where, as we press in, and turn our hearts to Him, He reveals his heart to us.

"After this I looked, and there before me was a door standing open in heaven. And the voice I had first heard speaking to me like a trumpet said, "Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after this." Rev 4:1

Revelations 4 vs 1 is the foundation scripture for Access41 and the door stands open for us to enter into His presence and His courts with Praise.

Our worship evenings are a special time as a family where we get to experience His love as we praise and worship our Father.

27. INHERITANCE

World's understanding of inheritance -You get something you never worked for. Money land etc.

Lack of inheritance in being parented produces people of moral and ethical questionability. Fatherlessness and lawlessness. Unable to maintain healthy relationships.

People who lack relationship inheritance have these symptoms:

- Lack of maturity in relationships. It is all about us and what we need, I don't serve they serve me. They need to make me feel special. I deserve better. Yes, maybe you do, but are you giving any better than you get.
- Lack of understanding of finance, self-control and discipline, failed relationships. Addictions.

Inheritance in Christ through His death

When we say yes to Jesus' invitation, we receive our inheritance from Him. We receive eternal life and open the doors to favour, provision, health, peace, joy, deliverance, identity, restitution and inheritance.

Zaccheus stopped and said to the Lord, "Behold, Lord, half of my possessions I will give to the poor, and if I have defrauded anyone of anything, I will give back four times as much." And Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because he, too, is a son of Abraham. Luke 19:8-9

When they had finished eating, Jesus said to Simon Peter, 'Simon son of John, do you love me more than these?' 'Yes, Lord,' he said, 'you know that I love you.' Jesus said, 'Feed my lambs.' Again, Jesus said, 'Simon son of John, do you love me?' He answered, 'Yes, Lord, you know that I love you.' Jesus said, 'Take care of my sheep.' The third time he said to him, 'Simon son of John, do you love me?' Peter was hurt because Jesus asked him the third time, 'Do you love me?' He said, "Lord, you know all things; you know that I love you.' Jesus said, "Feed my sheep." John 21:15-17

After loss restitution needs to happen. Sometimes you are someone else's restitution. Keep the pipeline flowing.

Patterns of restitution could be; discipleship, education, moral teaching, money, house etc. Access41 is in the restitution business.

Creating is part of your inheritance.

Don't react. Create.-- Brian Orme

An easy statement to read and flippantly saying it, it makes sense. Why get into a battle trying to defend or demolish arguments to situations that overwhelm us? Rather create a new one! Any situation, whether a crisis or a celebration, gives us two options. We either react or create.

See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland. Isaiah 43:19

At Access41 we change government and create.

As political and financial systems change, our inheritance is to create and by so doing to also bring restitution. Access41 is about changing government in our own lives, families, and countries. Create the new as part of your inheritance and legacy.

28. PRAYER APPS

This is short for "Personal Prayer Ministry Appointments". These are not counselling sessions but a time of connecting with God and getting His perspective on things. Whether you have unresolved past experiences, or you are reliving a trauma, or you are stuck in a particular pattern or cycle, or you just have difficulty hearing from God or connecting to others.

During a prayer app session, we invite Holy Spirit to shine His light on the root of what is going on, to expose wounds, memories and lies and we allow Him to minister to the individual.

The focus is on reconnection with the God and His love so that healing can take place and you can live the free, abundant life Jesus has for you.

29. HEBREW FESTIVALS

Access41 chooses to celebrate a few Old Testament festivals purely because of the prophetic significance that these 2 festivals have for us.

The 2 festivals we recognise are

- Pesach (Easter) is the story of Jesus final victory over the power of sin and darkness. We celebrate this time even though it is a sad time but it is even more a story of victory and love for us.
- Rosh Hashana. It is both the Hebrew new year and it was during this the time that Access 41 was formed several years ago. In this time, we try and sense what Pappa is saying in the coming year.

30. USE OF HEBREW

Access41 is not a Messianic organisation however we do often refer to Hebrew and the depth of the Hebrew meanings in our talks.

We have found that the church has largely ignored the significance of the Hebrew language.

By better understanding Hebrew words we can better understand the richness of the Bible. Many symbols and scriptures used in the Old Testament contain powerful and prophetic messages that highlight what Jesus came to do on the cross and beyond the cross.
